Voice Amplifiers

If your speech is clear, but you just cannot get loud enough for others to hear you, you may want to consider a voice amplifier.

The main thing to understand about voice amplifiers is that they simple amplify your speech. A voice amplifier will not make your speech easier to understand if it is slurred, only louder.

Occasionally we have voice amplifiers in the loan program, so check with the Assistive Technology Specialist before pursuing other methods of funding.

Be cautious when using insurance coverage for a voice amplifier. These are relatively inexpensive items. If your insurance purchases a voice amplifier, you may have difficulty getting any other communication device at a later date.
